Applicants who are not native English speakers and who have not completed coursework in an English-speaking university are required to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and achieve a minimum score of 550 on the paper-based test, 213 on the computer-based test, or 80 on the Internet-based test. International applicants must also submit a photocopy of the biographical information pages of their passport to the Admissions Office.
