The university is committed to providing an open environment for the examination of different philosophies and divergent ideas. The appearance of a speaker or program does not necessarily mean that the university endorses or supports the views expressed, nor that the sponsoring department or faculty member necessarily endorses or supports those views

CIIS faculty members are welcome to invite outside speakers to participate in any class which is a part of the university educational program. In such cases, the chair of the department involved is to be advised in advance of the intention to invite a guest speaker and agreement is to be given in advance to any honorarium to be granted that speaker. CIIS academic programs and faculty are also welcome to invite outside speakers to address students and faculty in the academic program or the university at large.
